Dr. Neeraj Agarwal

MD, FASCO

Professor of Medicine and Presidential Endowed Chair of Cancer Research, Huntsman Cancer Institute, University of Utah, USA

Dr. Neeraj Agarwal is a Professor of Medicine, and a Presidential Endowed Chair of Cancer Research at the Huntsman Cancer Institute (HCI), University of Utah. He also directs the Genitourinary Oncology (GU) Program, and the Center of Investigational Therapeutics (CIT) at the HCI.

Dr. Agarwal is an internationally recognized Physician-Scientist in the field of Genitourinary Cancers. He is the overall study chair of multiple Phase I/II and Phase III trials, and serves as a steering committee member of numerous other trials. He has received the SWOG Young Investigator Award, The William D. Odell Young Investigator Award, and The National Cancer Institute Cancer Clinical Investigator Team Leadership Award. After receiving his medical training at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences in New Delhi, he has completed a residency in internal medicine and a fellowship in Geriatric Medicine at the University of IOWA, followed by a Haematology-Oncology fellowship at HCI.

Dr. Agarwal has authored more than 450 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters. He serves as a panel member for The NCCN guideline committees for Bladder and Kidney cancers. He is an advisor to the Oncology Drug Advisory Committee and The United States Food and Drug Administration and leads early Therapeutics in The SWOG Genitourinary Cancers committee. He holds numerous scientific communications leadership roles, including Chief Editor of The ASCO Daily News, specialty editor for ASCO's cancer.net site, and Editorial board member of several journals, including the Journal of Clinical Oncology and European Urology. He also serves as a member of the ASCO Genitourinary Cancers Advisory Panel. Recently, Dr. Agarwal was appointed as the Senior Director for Clinical Research, directly reporting to the Cancer Center Director at the Huntsman Cancer Institute (HCI).

Eugene P. Frenkel, M.D. Scholar in Clinical Medicine Co-Leader, Kidney Cancer Program Co-Leader, Experimental Therapeutics Associate Professor, Internal Medicine Division of Hematology and Oncology UT Southwestern

Dr. Hans Hammers, M.D., Ph.D., is a Professor in the Department of Internal Medicine at UT Southwestern Medical Center, and a member of the Division of Hematology and Oncology. He is the inaugural Eugene P. Frenkel, M.D. Scholar in Clinical Medicine.

Originally from Germany, Dr. Hammers received his medical and doctoral degrees from the Medical University of Luebeck. He completed his internal medicine residency training at Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center in Baltimore and received advanced training through a fellowship program in medical oncology at the Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center at Johns Hopkins University.

At Johns Hopkins, Dr. Hammers led the kidney cancer research efforts and played a major role in the development of immunotherapy with immune checkpoint inhibitors in kidney cancer. His work in immunotherapy has been nationally recognized, and he has been the principal investigator on several industry- and investigator-sponsored trials.

Certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine in medical oncology, Dr. Hammers joined the UT Southwestern faculty in 2016.

Dr. Hammers is the Co-Leader of Clinical Research and Immunotherapy for the Kidney Cancer Research Program and is using his research efforts to develop novel immunotherapies for kidney cancer.

Dr. Hammers is a member of the American Society of Clinical Oncology, the American Association for Cancer Research, and the Society for Immunotherapy of Cancer.

Dr. Shilpa Gupta, MD, is a prominent oncologist and researcher at the Cleveland Clinic's Department of Haematology and Medical Oncology, specializing in the treatment and study of genitourinary (GU) cancers, which include cancers of the bladder, kidney, and prostate. She completed her medical degree in India before moving to the United States for further training, including an internal medicine residency, followed by a fellowship in Haematology and Oncology. Over her career, Dr. Gupta has earned a reputation for her deep commitment to clinical research and patient-centered care.

One of Dr. Gupta's primary research areas is immunotherapy, where she works on leveraging the body's immune system to combat cancer more effectively. She has been involved in multiple groundbreaking clinical trials that explore novel treatment approaches, often combining immunotherapy with other targeted treatments to improve efficacy. Her work is not only influential in advancing treatments but is also instrumental in personalizing therapies to meet the unique needs of each patient, a concept known as precision medicine.

Dr. Gupta is also widely published in top medical journals and frequently presents her

findings at national and international oncology conferences. She collaborates with researchers worldwide and contributes to shaping clinical guidelines in genitourinary oncology. Known for her compassionate and holistic approach, she prioritizes open communication, ensuring that her patients are well-informed and comfortable with their treatment plans.

In addition to her clinical and research roles, Dr. Gupta is committed to mentoring the next generation of oncologists and researchers, guiding medical fellows and young doctors. Her leadership and dedication continue to make a significant impact on the field of oncology, particularly in improving the quality of life and survival rates for those affected by GU cancers.
